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**cowl clo #1** english

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## About design

COWL CLO #1 is a collar that can be worn in your favourite sweater. The cowl is worked top down in round. It is a perfect gift!

COWL CLO #1 was designed with those odd balls and leftover skeins of fingering weight yarn and mohair we all have in our stashes, but it can also be worked in a single strand of DK weight yarn.

# MATERIAL

- ★ 1 strand of Knitting for Olive Merino (250m) 1 ball held together with 1 strand of Knitting for Olive Soft Silk Mohair (225m) 1 ball. Sample in Merino Oatmeal colorway and Soft Silk Mohair Marzipan or Merino cream + Soft silk mohair cream
- ★ Circular needles 4 mm with a cable of at least 60cm + one 40cm
- ★ 1 sewing needle
- ★ 1 marker



# Infos

The little cowl measures approximately diameter 43cm to 80 cm  
These dimensions are given after blocking.

# Gauge

24 sts and 28 rounds of lace pattern (needle 4mm)  
after blocking



*It is very important to read all of instructions before you start to familiarize yourself with construction.*

# Explications points

ssk (modified) Slip 1 st knitwise, knit 1 stitch and passo

K2tog  
Knit 2 stitches together

yo  
yarn over



# INSTRUCTIONS

With 4 mm / 40 cm [16"] circular needle, and 1 strand of Merino and 1 strand of Soft Silk Mohair held together, cast on 120 sts using long tail method. Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist sts and place BOR marker.

Set up Round: (k1tbl, p1) to end of round  
Work in rib pattern as established 17 more rounds.

## LACE SECTION

*change to longer cable length when required*

R1: Knit all stitches

R2: \*(K3, P3, K2) repeat from \* to end of round

R3: \*(K1, yo, K2, P3, K2, yo) repeat from \* to end of round

R4: \*(K4, P3, K3) repeat from \* to end of round

R5: \*(K1, yo, K3, P3, K3, yo) repeat from \* to end of round

R6: \*(K5, P3, K4) repeat from \* to end of round

R7: \*(K1, yo, K4, P3, K4, yo) repeat from \* to end of round

R8: \*(K6, P3, K5) repeat from \* to end of round

R9: \*(K1, yo, K5, P3, K4, yo) repeat from \* to end of round

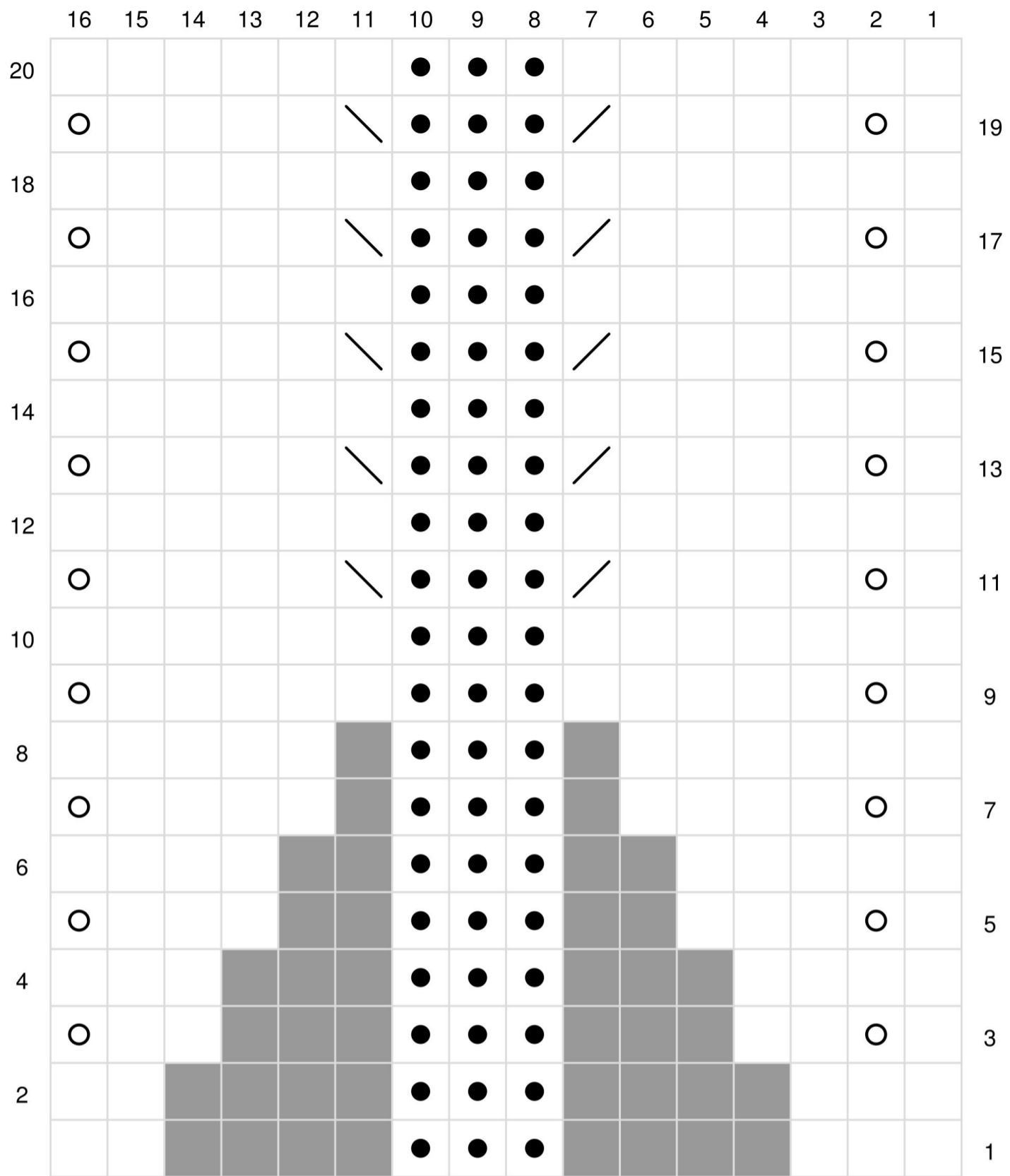
R10: \*(K7, P3, K6) repeat from \* to end of round (240 stitches)

R11: \*(K1, yo, K4, K2tog, P3, ssk, K4, yo) repeat from \* to end of round

R12 : \*(K7, P3, K6) repeat from \* to end of round

R13 to R20 : repeat R11 and R12

\*(Bind off 1stitch in knit, Bind off 1 stich in purl) repeat from \* to end of round



- RS: endroit - knit  
WS: envers - purl
- RS: envers - purl  
WS: endroit - knit
- \ surjet simple - ssk
- / 2m ens end - k2tog
- jeté - yarn over
- pas de mailles - no stitches

## FINISHING

Weave in all yarn ends neatly. Wet block to measurements

### TIPS

You can CO and BO with a 4,5mm needles to have a loosely effect.





## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>BO</b>	Bind off
<b>CO</b>	Cast on
<b>est</b>	Established
<b>K/k</b>	Knit
<b>K2tog</b>	Knit 2 stitches on L needle together (1 stitch decreased; leans right)
<b>p</b>	Purl
<b>pm</b>	Place a marker
<b>R</b>	Right
<b>RS</b>	Righth Side
<b>st/sts</b>	Stitch/Stitches
<b>WS</b>	Wrong Side
<b>yo</b>	Yarn over

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
